



Camping Instructions

- Campsites must be vacated prior to 12:00 noon on the date permit expires. Cottages/cabins must be vacated by 11:00 a.m. on your check out date.
- Ohio department of Health Regulations requires a minimum separation of 15 feet between camping structures. Your camping structure includes any awnings or canopies attached to your RV. Please observe this rule in setting up camp so that there are at least 15 feet between your camping structure.
- In accordance with the Sandusky Fire Code, ground fires are prohibited. Please do not leave grill fires unattended.
- Your pets are welcomed at Camper Village if kept leashed on your site only. Do not leave pets unattended. For your convenience a pet check is available near the main entrance of the amusement park. Pets are not permitted in cottages/cabins.
- Please clean up after your pet.
- No bicycles, skateboards, scooters, roller skates or roller blades may be operated on Cedar Point property.
- Trenching in or around sites is not permitted.
- Closed containers must be used for collecting any liquid waste from your RV. Empty at designated places.
- Dishwashing is not allowed at drinking fountains or in restrooms.
- Any use of firearms or fireworks is prohibited.
- Visitors must register at the office and leave their cars in the designated parking area.
- Quiet hours are appreciated by other campers. Please keep noise at a minimum from 12 midnight to 8 a.m.
- Campers are not permitted to walk barefoot on Cedar Point property.
- **NO TENTS PERMITTED**
- Anyone wishing to enter the amusement area must purchase tickets.
